### The Best Homemade Alfredo Sauce Ever

### Ingredients:

1 cup of butter

1 tsp. minced garlic

8 oz. cream cheese

2 tsp. garlic powder

2 pints heavy whipping cream

½ tsp. salt

2 tsp. Italian seasoning

½ tsp. pepper

2 cups grated parmesan cheese

In a med. saucepan combine butter, cream, & cream cheese. Cook over medium heat and whisk until melted. Add garlic, garlic powder, Italian seasoning, salt & pepper. Continue to whisk until smooth. Add parmesan cheese. Bring to a simmer and continue to cook for 3-5 min. or until it starts to thicken.
