#### **CHILI PARTY DIP**


#### JUNE 5th



This tax year, 2011, does not have a lot of changes for us. Much of the hype is on what will happen with 2013 tax laws. Those could be especially onerous. The experts do not expect much, if anything, to happen until years end. Given past performance that could be very troublesome. With no action laws will revert back to the 9/11 laws.

Linda reminded us that this years deadline is April 17<sup>th</sup>, so if you really want to push the envelope!!!!! She also discussed required minimum distributions, gift & estate taxes, charitable contributions and finally personal residence "gain" exclusions.

Linda also provided us with several handouts that are very helpful.

She finished with a Q&A session that was lively and also stayed after the meeting to answer further inquiries. The board thanks Linda for her time.
