We are starting to have discussions about the workers' Rights amendments in Illinois. it will be the first of its kind to make Right to Work illegal in this state. it will be a constitutional amendment that will be voted on in November. Please come to Union meetings to hear discussions about how important this actually is for all of us. Remember our pensions rely on our members working.

APRIL 13TH 2022 SPEAKER

Our speaker today was Mike Gogola He's a Business Representative as well as the Lead Organizer for Local #134. His dad was an IBEW member. Mike worked two years with a non union electrical contractor that was organized and Mike started his apprenticeship. As Business Representative, his jurisdiction is the Northwest Suburbs and O'hare Airport. In 2017 Business Manager Don Finn asked Mike to organize the unorganized. Mike could speak read and write Polish and this helped with the East European workers.

In 2017 nine new shops were added with 64 A cards 17 C cards and 5 CTA cards. In 2018 fourteen new shops were added 57 A cards 38 C cards and 9 B cards. In 2019 sixteen new shops were added 84 A cards 26 C cards and 23 CTA cards. In 2020 nine new shops were added 32 A cards and 7 C cards. In 2021 eight new shops were added 32 A cards and 35 C cards. So far this year six new shops were added with 16 A cards and 1 C card. This totals 62 new shops and 427 new members.

Mike tries to convince non union shop owners to be Fair listed. He visits job sites to organize and told of salting techniques to strip workers from non union contractors that are used. The IBEW sets standards on how to organize.

As for the new workers there are special classes for potential apprentices. Non union J Ws after 7seven years can take a test to join Local #134. Mike also said John Cambell is a newly hired organizer. We want to thank Mike for his time and efforts and for sharing this information with us. We wish you Good Luck.
