Buffalo Cauliflower Biters

Ingredients:

- 1 head cauliflower
- ¾ cup flour
- 1 tsp. paprika
- 1 tsp. onion powder
- 1 tsp. garlic powder
- 1 tsp. salt
- 34 cup buttermilk
- 5 Tbsp. buffalo sauce
- 2 Tbsp. butter, melted
- Fresh Parsley, chopped

Directions:

Preheat oven to 375 degrees and line two baking sheets with parchment paper. Set aside.

Cut cauliflower into florets. In a large bowl combine flour, spices and salt. Add the buttermilk and whisk until combined. Add cauliflower to the buttermilk batter and stir to coat. Place on prepared baking sheets, leaving space between each floret.

Bake for 20 minutes. Flip florets over and bake another 20 minutes. Meanwhile whisk together melted butter and buffalo sauce in a large bowl. Remove cauliflower from oven and lightly toss in prepared sauce. Garnish with parsley and serve immediately.
